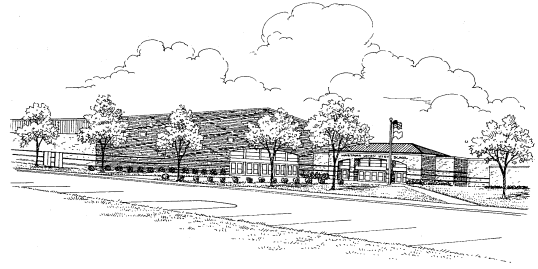

BUS TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Dear Students and Parents:

Who is Transported



It is our policy to transport all students who live two miles or more from the high school building, providing that the student lives outside the City of Hartford limits. Currently that is approximately 800 students daily. Our intent is to make pick-ups so no student has to walk more than one-third mile on government cared-for roads to board a bus.

Rules and Regulations

Transporting your child/children must be accomplished in the safest and best way possible. The responsibility for this task lies in the hands of the school bus driver who must keep order on the bus while safely driving your child/children to and from school. Disruptive riders could endanger the safety of the entire bus. With the safety and welfare of your child/children in mind, the Board of Education has established Policy #8600 "Transportation" and these specific bus guidelines are covered in the Parent/Student Handbook which will be online and available in the transportation section at www.huhs.org. Parents and students must realize that the school bus is an extension of the classroom and students must abide by these rules.

Shuttle Service available for Students who live in the City of Hartford at a cost:

The district **does not** provide transportation to students living within the city limits of Hartford. However, Wittenberger Bus Service **does offer** a shuttle service to and from school. Transportation tickets must be purchased through the bus company in person, by mail, or through the bus driver. Each ride will require a ticket.

Ticket prices are as follows:

- 360 tickets - \$360
- 100 tickets - \$125
- 40 tickets - \$56
- 20 tickets - \$30
- 1 ticket - \$2

Tickets are required for each and every bus ride, or transportation will be **denied**. Pick-ups are at corners along the designated route.

City Route: Bus #38 HIGH SCHOOL CITY First stop 6:45 a.m. Foxtail and Broodmore, Park Knoll and Cleveland, then Wacker and State. State St. to Forest, north to Prospect, east to Main, South to Highland, east to Sixth, south to Union, east to Riverbend. South on Wilson, to Loos, West to Cedar to high school.

BUS ROUTES AND SCHEDULE PICK-UPS

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL – WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 1, 2010 - Note Day Schedule:

- Freshmen start at 7:25 a.m. - Full Day - Lunch will be served
- Sophs/Jrs/Seniors start at 11:30 a.m. - Partial Day – 4 Hours later

There will be two complete route pick-ups. Please note below by class:



FRESHMEN:

The first bus pick-up start is at **6:00 a.m.** for **freshmen only**. **Be sure to bring along your class schedule that you received during registration.** Check the attached tentative route schedule for specific time information. It is important for students to be at a bus stop **early** because of the uncertainty of the tentative schedule of stops.

SOPH/JRS/SENIORS:

The second bus pick-up for **sophomores, juniors and seniors** will be starting at approximately **10:15 a.m.** The second half of the day will begin at **11:30 a.m.**, which will include all classes. Check the attached tentative route schedule for specific time information and allow for the time variance for the first day. **Be sure to bring along your class schedule that you received during registration.**

During the first few days it is very important for students to be at a bus stop **early** because of the uncertainty of the tentative schedule of stops. The bus drivers will, for these first few days, be watching for students who may be at non-assigned stops. However, after that, it is important for students to be at assigned stops **on time**.

Attached is a tentative schedule for place and time of pick up points for a normal school day. They are based on last year's experience and on the data we have available for this coming year.
